What is Read to Succeed?

Read to Succeed is a group based program designed to improve literacy skills for children entering kindergarten to first grade. Participants learn by doing and exploring literacy to create a motivating environment. Each lesson introduces a reading skill and strategy while implementing phonological awareness, fluency, vocabulary and reading comprehension. Individual goals are addressed for children who have been identified as "at risk" in the area of literacy. These students may also have been diagnosed with a language disorder or speech sound disorder.

Read to Succeed is led by a licensed speech-language pathologist with the support of graduate student clinicians.
