What is SLICK?

SLICK is a six-week, intensive language therapy program for children who have language and learning disorders.

The camp is for children who have finished 1st grade through children who have finished 6th grade.

Our mission is to provide a fun learning environment and to build children's language skills through literacy-based activities.

Large Group Activities

Large group activities each day will focus on listening comprehension, narrative development, executive skills, and vocabulary-building in the context of shared reading interactions and curriculum-related activities.

Small Group Therapy

Two 30-minute therapy sessions each day will focus on children's selected language goals with a clinician.



The SLICK Program:

- is developed by speech-language pathologists that tailor therapy to each child's individual needs;
