



What is Super Speech?

Super Speech is a speech and articulation group designed for preschool- and kindergarten-age children who have speech sound errors. The program is appropriate for children who have mild to severe speech sound disorders and delays. These children intend to communicate but struggle to be understood by familiar and unfamiliar listeners. We work with children to improve their overall speech quality and intelligibility.

Super Speech adopts a hybrid approach using both play-based techniques and drill practice to maximize progress toward individual goals. The environment is motivating and exciting to engage the children and encourage improvement. The program targets individual goals, overall speech sound quality and pre-reading skills (phonological awareness). The Super Speech program is led by a certified, licensed speech-language pathologist with the support of graduate and undergraduate clinicians.

Super Speech Targets:

- Speech sound production (beginning at the sound level)
- Development of oral motor skills for accurate movement of lips, tongue, cheeks and muscles of the mouth area
- Increased awareness of appropriate phonological patterns
- Increased overall speech intelligibility
