



Little Listeners is a therapy program for infants and toddlers with hearing aids and/or cochlear implants designed to develop listening, language, and speech skills in new listeners and train caregivers in therapy strategies and techniques to use at home.

Home Model

Little Listeners uses a home model with a pretend kitchen, bathroom, and bedroom, so you can learn to use therapy strategies in daily activities like feeding, dressing, bathing, grooming, cleaning, and playing. You will learn new therapy strategies every week and be coached through opportunities to practice using these strategies in a home setting.

Family Support

You will train with other families who have children with hearing loss and have opportunities to share questions, ideas, and learn from each other.

Group and Individual

Little Listeners trains some listening skills with all families together as a group. We also train personalized skills individually with you, your child, and your clinician.

Little Listeners is led by a licensed Speech-Language Pathologist and certified Auditory Verbal Therapist with the support of graduate student clinicians.

A caregiver must participate in all sessions.
